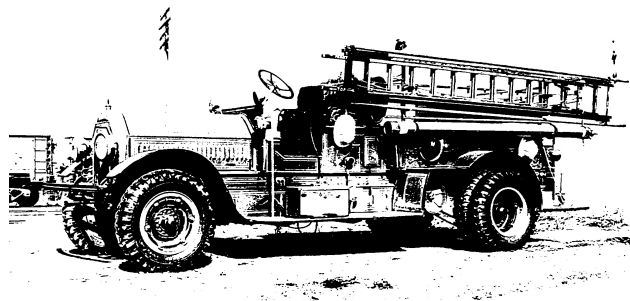

In 1973, the Southern Pacific Railroad Depot in downtown Livermore faced imminent demolition. A group of local citizens realized the Depot was one of many pieces of Livermore's heritage that could be lost and they organized to save them. This led to the founding of the Guild, and the Depot was saved.
